1. 2006 Motor Fuel Tax Resolution

Purpose: A resolution has been prepared to authorize the expenditure of \$1,880,000 of Motor Fuel

Tax (MFT) funds for the Maintenance of Highways by Municipality Under the Illinois Highway Code. This resolution will allow the Village to use MFT funds. It does not authorize any work, as that will occur at a later date via authorization of a contract

2. Grant Application and Agreement: Public Education & Enforcement Research Study

A resolution has been prepared to authorize submission of a grant application and **Purpose:**

agreement to the Illinois Commerce Commission and Federal Railroad Administration requesting funding in the amount of \$17,272 to implement a well-defined program of education and enforcement targeted at reducing or eliminating pedestrian and motor

vehicle grade crossing violations

3. Conservation Land Stewardship Proposal for 2006 Lacey Creek Management and Stewardship Activities

Purpose: A motion is requested authorizing an agreement with Conservation Land Stewardship

("CLS") in the amount of \$20,546.94. This agreement allows CLS to complete year five of the five-year maintenance and monitoring program as required by DuPage County to ensure that the streambank stabilization project along Lacey Creek is maturing in

accordance with the original plans of the project.
