RESOLUTION NO. 95-16

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CERTAIN POLICIES RELATED TO THE NAMING OF PUBLIC BUILDINGS BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DOWNERS GROVE, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, on June 19, 1978, the Village Council of the Village of Downers Grove adopted Resolution No. 78-30 which established a Council policy concerning the naming of buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has recently reviewed that policy and desires to make certain changes thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that it is necessary to establish certain policies concerning the naming of public buildings and facilities of the Village and that these policies and procedures should be clearly set out by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Council intends that this resolution be an advisory statement concerning policies and procedures regarding naming of public buildings and facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Downers Grove, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

1. That Resolution No. 78-30 is hereby repealed.
2. Buildings, rooms, and/or facilities owned by the Village may be named for individuals who have made exceptional contributions to the community by having met one or more of the specific criteria listed under Exhibit "A" of this resolution.

3. Buildings, rooms, and/or facilities owned by the Village may be named for elected or appointed public officials or public employees only after that individual has ceased to be an elected or appointed public official or public employee.

4. Buildings, rooms, and/or facilities owned by the Village may be named for individuals or groups who have made donations of land, money, or facilities to the Village.

5. A proposal to name a building, room, and/or facility owned by the Village may be acted upon no sooner than thirty (30) calendar days after having been placed on public file and on the Village Council agenda for a date certain for action.

6. An extraordinary majority vote of the Village Council shall be required to name a building, room, and/or facility owned by the Village.

7. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.

8. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.

EXHIBIT "A"

1. The individual must have made a contribution to the community which resulted in the improved well being of the people of Downers Grove.

2. The individual must have been actively involved in Downers Grove community affairs for no less than (3) three years.

3. The contribution by the individual must be of an exceptional quality and/or significance.

4. The efforts of the individual must have made a significant and major contribution in assisting the Village of Downers Grove to achieve its community goals and objectives.
