DISCUSSION:

The Village of Downers Grove opened bids for our annual supply of crushed limestone on Thursday, February 14, 2002.

The Public Works Department received five (5) bids for the supply of crushed limestone, of the five vendors; three offer both picked up and delivered prices per ton of material. The other two vendors offer only delivered prices. Public Works requires the ability to pick-up materials if we have an emergency and need a special type of limestone or sand. Vulcan Construction Materials bid a FA-6 (fine aggregate) sand instead of the FA-2 sand. We use FA-2 sand for mixing concrete and crack filling operations.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Public Works recommendation to the Village Council is to award the contract for the supply of crushed limestone to Boughton Trucking and Materials, Inc. When needed Boughton is very prompt with their deliveries. In the past winters when we experienced numerous water main breaks in succession and our stockpile of gravel was low, Boughton did a great job keeping us supplied with gravel in the extreme cold weather even as it was difficult to get equipment and trucks to start.

We even have an emergency phone number, if we ever run out of material, we can obtain it. The services to the Village have been excellent in the past.
