The meeting commenced at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Sandack welcomed the Liquor Commissioners to the meeting and thanked them for attending.

Commissioner Sandack and Commissioner Tully explained that it is a goal of the Council to meet with each of the Village boards and commissions. This is a means for the Council to introduce themselves and answer questions volunteers may have about serving on a Village board. In addition, they explained that these meetings will give the Council opportunity to share their expectations and obtain information on what direction the boards and commissions are taking.

Mayor Krajewski thanked the Liquor Commissioners for providing him with lively discussion and recommendations during application and disciplinary hearings. He appreciated the fact that it makes his job easier in the thoroughness of their commentary.

The group discussed the duties of the Liquor Commission. It was agreed that disciplinary and application hearings are a main aspect of commission duties, but that it would be beneficial for the commission to conduct periodic reviews of the ordinance and address existing policy.

Liquor Commission members agreed that it would be best to meet every month even though an application or disciplinary hearing was not on the agenda. During these meetings the commission could review the ordinance and discuss policy.

The group discussed various issues related to the sale and service of alcohol. Both the Liquor Commissioners and Council members agreed that this meeting was a good means by which to share information and get guidance from each other on how to succeed in further review of the Ordinance and liquor control policies.
