Adoption of the attached ordinance will make certain amendments to those fees paid to the Village for emergency response services.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FEES FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE SERVICES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Downers Grove in DuPage County, Illinois, as follows: (Additions are indicated by ~~_____~~/_____; deletions by ~~_____~~):

Section 1. That Section 17.24. is hereby amended to read as follows:

17.24. Interference with inspections.

No person shall in any manner interfere with the fire chief ~~or his designee~~ while he is engaged in the investigation, inspection or examination of any building in the Village, or, who shall prevent him from making such inspection, investigation or examination. (R.O. 1925, § 172.)

Section 2. That Section 17.28. is hereby amended to read as follows:

17.28. Emergency Medical Service and Transportation Fee.

(a) The following fees shall be imposed upon each person who uses emergency medical service and/or transportation provided by the Downers Grove Fire Department:

Basic Life Support Calls	\$275 <u>\$350.00</u>	350.00 <u>\$450.00</u>
Advanced Life Support I Calls	\$350 <u>\$500.00</u>	\$425 <u>\$600.00</u>
Cardiac Monitor	\$100	\$100
Oxygen	\$50.0	\$50
Advanced Life Support II Calls	\$550.00	\$700.00
Mileage-per loaded mile	\$5.00	\$5.00

(b) No fee shall be charged to any person for emergency medical services provided under the following conditions:

- (1) The person is a Village employee and the emergency services and/or transportation provided are related to an injury or illness covered by the Village's worker's compensation or Village health insurance;
- (2) The person dies prior to being admitted to the hospital; or
- (3) The Village Manager or his designee may waive the fee, or a portion of the fee, if he determines that the person is incapable of paying the fee.

Section 3. That Section 17.47. is hereby amended to read as follows:

17.47. Permit, Inspection, Training and OSHA Fees.

No permit shall be issued or inspection conducted until all fees described in this Section and any outstanding fees have been paid in full.

(a) Permit fees are as follows:

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Open Burning Permit (per occurrence)	\$40.00
Fireworks Permit (per occurrence)	\$50.00
Spray Booth Permit (annual)	\$50.00
Underground Petroleum Storage (annual)	\$150.00
LPG Storage and Sales (annual)	\$35.00
Tar Kettle Permit (per occurrence)	\$50.00

(b) Inspection fees are as follows:

Hydro Static Test	\$70.00
Fire Alarm Acceptance Test	\$70.00
Temporary Use Permit Inspections	\$40.00
Amusement Ride (per inspector)	\$50.00
Walk Through	\$25.00
Reinspections:	
Second reinspection	\$25.00
Subsequent reinspection(s)	\$50.00

(c) Fire Extinguisher Training	\$50.00 \$75.00/hour
Fire Watch Personnel	\$50.00 per person/per hour
Fire Watch Apparatus	\$150.00 per hour

Section 4. That Section 19.40. is hereby amended to read as follows:

19.40. Permit required; compliance with chapter.

Any person desiring to plow, dig, scrape or in any way make or have made any hole, pit, ditch or excavation in or upon any street, alley, parkway or public land shall proceed with such work only after obtaining a permit therefor and in compliance with all regulations contained in or promulgated under this chapter including the Village of Downers Grove Standards for the Construction of Facilities on the Public Rights-of-Way (copies of which may be obtained at the Public Works Department and the Code Services Department. ~~The Downers Grove Fire Department shall be notified of the issuance of such permit~~ (Ord. No. 843, § 15.)

Section 9. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 10. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
