Adoption of the attached ordinance will amend turning restrictions at Maple Avenue and Main Street.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TURNING RESTRICTIONS AT MAIN STREET AND MAPLE AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Downers Grove in DuPage County, Illinois, as follows: (Additions are indicated by /underline; deletions by ~~strikeout~~):

Section 1. That Section 14.8. is hereby amended to read as follows:

14.8. "No turn on red" intersections.

(a) On the basis of traffic investigations at the below named intersections, it is found that traffic conditions do not safely allow turns on a red light and that the following intersections should be designated as "No turn on red" intersections:

Fairview Avenue and Lincoln Street, north and south approaches only.

Main Street and Burlington Avenue.

Main Street and Curtiss Street.

Main Street and Grant Street.

Maple Avenue and Main Street, ~~east approach only.~~

39th Street and Fairview Avenue, west approach only.

(b) On the basis of traffic investigations at the below named intersections, it is found that traffic conditions do not safely allow turns on a red light and that vehicles facing a steady red signal shall be prohibited from turning right after stopping at all times when pedestrians are present in the vicinity of the following intersections:

Belmont Road and Prairie Avenue, east approach only.

Fairview Avenue and Hill Street, south approach only.

Fairview Avenue and Prairie Avenue, north approach only.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
