SYNOPSIS

A motion is requested to authorize award of a contract for excavating debris hauling services to Salce Inc. of Downers Grove, Illinois in the amount of \$48,000.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT

The Five Year Plan and Goals for 2006-2011 identified *Exceptional Municipal Organization*. A supporting objective of this goal is *Top Quality Core Services Responsive to Current and Future Community and Citizen Needs*.

FISCAL IMPACT

The FY 2006 General Fund and Water Fund budgets provide \$42,000 and \$30,000 respectively, based on the 8-month fiscal year adjustment, for excavating debris hauling and disposal. This contract involves engaging the services of a trucking company to haul excavating debris generated as a result of Public Works activities to area landfills. The budgeted funds also provide for the landfill tipping fees that are paid directly by the Village.

RECOMMENDATION

Approval on the September 5, 2006 consent agenda.

BACKGROUND

The contract to provide services for debris hauling was competitively bid for FY 2006, with one bid received. The contract amount is based on hauling approximately 255 truckloads of debris. The bid received is summarized below:

There are a limited number of potential vendors available to perform this work due to the amount of significant construction projects ongoing throughout the Chicago area requiring hauling services. This contract was re-bid after receiving no responses following the initial release of bid documents. Hauling of excavating debris is generally conducted on a monthly basis throughout the year. The price for this service last year was \$71.25 per hour.
